## **Fall Protection Awareness**

\$169.00 per student

*Course Format: Classroom and practical exercises*

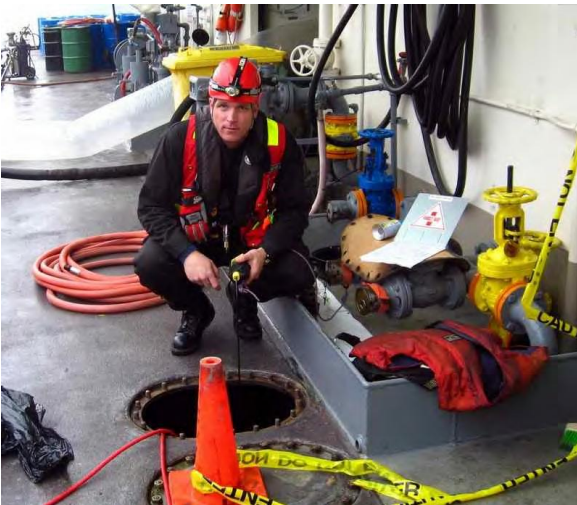
*Certification: Certificate of Attendance upon successful completion*

*Pre-requisites: Nil*

This course is intended for any person that will be required to work at a height where fall protection is necessary as per the definition provided in local work safe regulations. Students will be presented a combination of theoretical and practical training with current, approved fall protection equipment. The training includes definitions, hierarchy of fall protection, calculating freefall distance and fall clearance, identification and inspection of required equipment, harness fitting, fall protection plans, and practical and written exercises followed by written confirmation of skills.

## **Principles of Confined Space**

*Pre-requisites: Nil*

This course is intended for any personnel that will be entering, working in, providing standby for or monitoring confined spaces. Real case scenarios are examined. This program meets the training requirements that allow workers to enter and work in confined spaces as required by applicable provincial/state or international regulations. This training includes not only the applicable regulations, but also an introduction to air monitoring and scenario based evolutions. The course consists of both a classroom lecture in confined spaces and practical scenarios.

## **Confined Space Rescue – 2 Day Non IDLH**

*Certification: Certificate of Attendance upon successful completion*

*Pre-requisites: Nil*

This course is intended for individuals that will be employed as rescue persons in a confined space capacity, but not in an IDLH environment. Personnel are trained in not only the hazards and entry requirements of confined spaces, but also some of the required rescue competencies as outlined in NFPA 1006 and NFPA 1670. The competencies include but are not limited to, ropes and knots, hazard recognition and appropriate control measures, patient packaging, atmospheric monitoring and toxicology. The course concludes with practical scenarios of varying difficulty in multiple types of confined spaces.

## **Confined Space Rescue – 4 Day IDLH**

*Course Duration: 4 days*

*Course Format: Classroom and practical exercises*

*Certification: Certificate of Attendance upon successful completion*

*Pre-requisites: Nil*

This course is intended for individuals that will be employed as rescue persons for confined space entries, in an immediately dangerous to life and health (IDLH) environment. Personnel are trained in recognizing hazards and the entry requirements of confined spaces, as well as some of the required rescue competencies as outlined in NFPA 1006 and NFPA 1670. These include but are not limited to, ropes and knots, hazard recognition and appropriate control measures, patient packaging, atmospheric monitoring and toxicology. The course concludes with practical scenarios of varying difficulty in multiple types of confined spaces.
