Canpro was invited to participate in the first annual WorkSafe BC Young Worker Safety Event 2009 held in Richmond, BC. We provided a variety of displays which included such subjects as fall protection, confined space and technical patient packaging.

We suspended participants in a fall protection harness to give an understanding of what one may feel like while explaining the equipment on display. The confined space display was positioned over an underground vault access point. This included a tripod with mechanical advantage system, a positive pressure fan with ducting, and a gas detector.

We were also asked to arrange a first aid display, demonstrating CPR which was provided by our friends at Critical Link First Aid. It was great to be involved in this event, teaching the young workers of tomorrow's workforce the dangers and available protective measures of confined spaces and work activities which have fall hazards.
